

● KG-2 STUDENTS LEARN ADVANCED SCIENCE TOPICS USING UNIQUE AND SIMPLIFIED LEARNING TECHNIQUES

This month in KG2 our little learners have had a wonderful time taking part in a variety of structured and independent activities designed to foster their creativity, critical thinking skills and application of concepts. In Science we have been exploring the topic of Pushes and Pulls where we investigated the effects of forces on the movement of different objects. We then deepened our scientific enquiry into the topic of Speed and Direction, where we explored and analysed the effect of altering the speed in which a force is applied to the direction of an object. The students have thoroughly enjoyed this unit and amazed their teachers with their ability to recall key vocabulary, make predictions, test out an idea and make scientific connections to the real world!

● GRADE 4 ENGINEERS BUILD THEIR OWN DOLL-HOUSES WITH LIGHTS, HEATERS, DOORBELLS AND FANS.

Our future Engineers, Project Managers, and Architects in Grade 4 designed and constructed their own dollhouses from scratch. They started with Blueprints then added electricity to generate different forms energy: Motion, Light, Heat & Sound by building fans, heaters, doorbells and lights in their dollhouses. This was part of the Electrical Currents Science Unit.



● GRADE 5 GIRLS MADE THEIR OWN FRAGRANCES

On a trip to Sharjah Islamic Museum, our girls from 5A learned about Islamic History and footprints in science, art and more. During the trip they were introduced to the primitive ways of extracting rose water and were given the chance to mix their very own perfumes at the lab provided by Sharjah Islamic Museum. It was indeed a fun and fruitful experience for them! They also had the chance to explore many art pieces and find out about the latest technologies in UAE.
